

CALENDAR FOR EARLY VOTING FOR: **March 2, 2010 Primary Election**

January 1, 2010 **First day to accept applications for early voting by mail**

January 16, 2010 Early voting clerk may begin mailing early voting ballots to applicants (or as soon as ballots become available on or after this date)

February 1, 2010 Last day to register to vote for the March 2, 2010 Primary Election or change voter registration information to be effective for the primary election

February 10, 2010 Last day for a person to **submit** a federal postcard application who is **not a registered voter** to receive a **full** ballot (true FPCA)

February 11, 2010 If an FPCA is received by this date without a postmark to prove mailing date, the EV clerk will accept it and mail a full ballot if applicant is not permanent registered to vote but meets requirements under Title 2 of the Election Code.

February 16, 2010 **BEGINNING DAY FOR EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE AT MAIN EARLY VOTING LOCATION**

February 20, 2010 **SATURDAY EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.**

February 21, 2010 **SUNDAY EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE 12 noon to 5:00 P.M.**

February 22, 2010 A voter who becomes sick or disabled on or after this date may vote a late ballot if the sickness or disability prevents the voter from appearing at the polling place without the likelihood of needing personal assistance or of injuring his or her health (Sec. 102.001, Election Code.)

February 23, 2010 **Last day to receive application for a ballot to be voted by mail**

February 27, 2010 First day to submit an application for and vote a Late ballot because of a death in the immediate family member that occurred on or after Thursday, February 25, 2010, and will require absence from the county on election day. (Secs. 103.001, 103.003(b)).

February 27, 2010 First day to submit an application for and vote a late ballot because of sickness or disability that arose on or after Monday, February 22, 2010. (Secs. 102.001, 102.003).

February 26, 2010 **LAST DAY FOR EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE (Excepting emergency voting)**

March 2, 2010 **ELECTION DAY**

March 2, 2010 5:00 P.M. Deadline for receiving applications for late ballots to be voted by persons who became ill or disabled on or after February 22, 2010 (Sec. 102.003(b), Election Code).

March 2, 2010 7:00 P.M. Deadline for receiving early ballots by mail and late ballots cast by voters who became ill or disabled on or after February 22, 2010 (Secs. 86.007(a) and 102.006(c))

March 8, 2010 Last day to receive carrier envelopes from voters who are voting outside the United States (Sec. 86.007(d)(3)(B), Election Code)
