County Attorney Bianchi informed the Court of his status since he has declared his candidacy for County Court at Law Judge. He outlined the Court's options - take no action, replace him at any time or wait until after the November 2014 election. Both Commissioner Chaney and Commissioner Smith stated they saw no reason to go against the voters by replacing him at this time.

PRESS QUESTIONS

Norma Martinez with The Rockport Pilot asked if the agreement for disaster recovery should have been bid. The law has changed to a \$50,000.00 requirement for bidding. Road Administrator Vyoral stated professional services cannot even discuss the cost prior to reaching an agreement.

Ms. Martinez also questioned the Court's decision on the Transfer Station holidays. Commissioner Smith replied the Court wants to be consistent going forward and approve only the holidays for the next year and no the year after that.
