SPECIAL MEETING - JULY 16, 2010

CIAP FUNDS

Motion was made by Judge Mills and seconded by Commissioner Murph to approve allocation of \$500,000.00 in the 2009-2010 County CIAP funds from MMS to use with the proposed 4.5 million dollar state CIAP grant for the opening of Cedar Bayou.

Question. Motion carried unanimously.

CIAP GRANT APPLICANT

Judge Mills informed the Court County Attorney Richard Bianchi stated he (Judge Mills) must be the Project Manager.

Motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to approve naming Aransas County as applicant for 2009-2010 CIAP grant applications pertinent to Cedar Bayou and appointing Judge Mills as Project Manager.

Question. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Casterline asked if grant application was for Tier I or Tier II; Judge Mills replied Tier I. Judge Mills also stated that even though he is the Project Manager he will be calling on the Edwards who know more about Cedar Bayou than he does.
