

MINUTES OF THE

The Meeting was convened at 9:00 a.m. at which time a quorum was declared by Commissioner Smith, County Judge Pro-Tem, WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had and done to wit:

ITEM FOR DELIBERATION

Motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to approve the continued use of a forty (40) foot wide road way drainage easement in the Arrowhead Acre Subdivision for access by property owners to their property. The court stipulates that the County will maintain the drainage after clearing of drainage is completed by owners. The County also stipulates the road is a county road but the County will not maintain the road.
