Having considered the Agreed Motion for Order of Suspension and the Sworn Complaint. it is the Order of the Supreme Court of Texas that the Honorable William Adams, Judge of the County Court at Law, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, be immediately suspended from office, with pay, pending final disposition of the allegations made the basis of this inquiry or further orders of this Court.
