**COMMISSIONERS' COURT ORDER #0-08-2011  
DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR ARANSAS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of November, 2011, the County Judge issued a Proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Aransas County due to the imminent threat of financial and economic impact on the seafood industry, specifically shrimp and oysters, due to:

**DROUGHT RELATED RED TIDE; and**

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF ARANSAS COUNTY, TEXAS:


