2. Discuss, approve or disapprove authorizing Change Order No. 1, to the Waypoint contract originally executed on January 14, 2026, which authorized the procurement, installation and deployment of the Nutanix AHV solution under the Interlocal Purchasing System “TIPS”, Contract #230105 and the Texas Department of Information Resources Cooperative Purchasing Office (TX DIR CPO) Contract #5792; this change order does not affect the original contract price or add additional billable time, but allows the use of existing contract hours to mitigate, upgrade, and/or rebuild several systems identified during the course of the project that are not readily migrated off of the legacy computing environment – Collin Jackson/Jacky Cockerham/Judge Garza

3. Discuss, approve or disapprove selection of a responsible bidder for the Town of Fulton Streets and Drainage Project, including consideration of the recommendation to award the construction contract to Tex-Mix Paving, LLC, based on the Base Bid with Alternates #1 and #2, in the total amount of \$1,974,684.75, funded through the Texas General Land Office (GLO) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) MIT-MOD (Contract No. 24-065-1285-E986); and authorize the County Judge to execute the Notice of Award, Hiring Resolution, and all necessary related documents – Darrell Seibert/Commissioner Dupnik/Judge Garza

## VI. EXECUTIVE SESSION



In accordance with the authority of the Texas Government Code Sections 551.071, 551.072, 551.073, 551.074, 551.075, 551.076, 551.086, 551.087, 551.089, the Commissioners Court will hold an Executive Session to consult with attorney(s), including outside legal counsel on matters related to litigation; and to deliberate regarding real property, contract negotiations, prospective gift(s), personnel matters, county advisory bodies, security devices and deployments, competitive utility matters, economic development negotiations including incentives, and/or security audits or network vulnerability assessments. Upon completion of the Executive Session, the Commissioners Court may, in an open session, take such action as appropriate on items discussed in an Executive Session.*


