

MINUTES OF THE  
COMMISSIONERS' COURT

PUBLIC HEARING - OCTOBER 12, 2009

On the 12th day of October, 2009, there was a Special Meeting of the Commissioners' Court in the Courthouse, Rockport, Aransas County, Texas, with the following members present: C. H. "Burt" Mills, Jr., County Judge; Jack Chaney, Commissioner Precinct 1; Leslie "Bubba" Casterline, Commissioner Precinct 2; Charles Smith, Commissioner Precinct 3; Howard Murph, Commissioner 4; and Peggy L. Friebele, County Clerk.

Other County Officers present were Richard Bianchi, County Attorney; Jerry Brundrett, County Surveyor; David Vyoral, Road Administrator; Gene Johnson, Airport Manager; Dee Oliver, County Treasurer; Rick McLester, Chief Deputy Sheriff; Iris Sanchez, County Librarian; and Amy Freeman, Agricultural Extension Agent.

The Meeting was convened at 8:45 a.m. at which time a quorum was declared by Judge Mills, WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had and done to wit:

ARANSAS COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS

Judge Mills stated the purpose of the public hearing was to receive comments on the proposed Aransas County Subdivision Regulations.

Road Administrator Vyoral stated he advertised in the last two (2) newspapers and contacted the local realtors requesting comments. He received no response. County Surveyor Brundrett asked if the fee schedule would be approved at this time. Vyoral said it would not because it was not put on the Regular Agenda. Commissioner Smith asked when the regulations would be effective. Vyoral asked for a recommendation from Brundrett who asked if the subdivisions already in the preliminary stage would be affected. Vyoral replied they would not - only new subdivision. January 1, 2010 was the suggested effective date.
