ITEMS FOR DELIBERATION AND/OR ACTION

- 1. Jacky Cockerham reported no Budget Line Item transfers or amendments. A motion was made by Commissioner Casterline and seconded by Commissioner Chaney to approve (no) Budget Line Item Transfers and Amendments for this period. Question. Motion carried unanimously. It is so ordered.

She gave the Commissioners the information to consider on a handout and asked for their approval to cut a \$26,547.69 check to Good Samaritans from our COVID-19 Humanitarian Grant (Cares Act Funding) - the proceeds of which need to be spent by the end of December with the associated paperwork submitted by mid-December. She further explained that this money was grant money that the County gave to other entities earlier but was returned back to us because they didn't spend it. Good Samaritan spent all of the money we sent them earlier but had additional grant-eligible needs that could be met through these returned funds. A motion was made by Commissioner Chaney and seconded by Commissioner Casterline to approve the Accounts Payable item.

Question. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Chaney commented that Good Samaritan has done many wonderful things for our community. All present agreed.
