A special election is hereby ordered to be held on November 4, 2025, pursuant to Texas Tax Code Sections 26.05 and 26.08 to approve the ad valorem tax rate for Aransas Pass ISD because the adopted rate exceeds the APISD Voter-Approval Tax Rate ("VATR").

At the Election, the ballot proposition shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the District using the language required by statute:

THIS IS A TAX INCREASE

Ratifying the ad valorem tax rate of 0.8088 (adopted Tax Rate) in Aransas Pass ISD for the current year a rate that will result in an increase of 4% tax revenue under the adopted rate as compared to maintenance and operations tax revenue for the district for the current year as compared to the preceding year, which is an additional \$364,346.00.

Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted beginning on October 20 and ending on October 31, 2025.
