NOTICE ABOUT 2020 TAX RATES

Property Tax Rates in County of Aransas This notice concerns the 2020 property tax rates for County of Aransas. This notice provides information about two tax rates used in adopting the current tax year's tax rate. The no-new-revenue tax rate would impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. In most cases, the voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

Indigent Defense Compensation Expenditures

The County of Aransas spent \$ 363,860 from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 to provide appointed counsel for indigent individuals, less the amount of state grants received by the county. In the preceding year, the county spent \$293,437 for indigent defense compensation expenditures. The amount of increase above last year's indigent defense expenditures is \$70,423. This increased the voter-approval rate by \$0.000517 /\$100 to recoup the increased expenditures.
