The draft EA evaluates alternatives that provide for compliance with applicable environmental laws. The alternatives evaluated include (1) No Action; (2) the Proposed Action described above.

The draft EA is available for review online on the Aransas County website at <u>www.aransascountytx.gov</u>. A hard copy of the EA will be available at the Aransas County Courthouse at 2840 Hwy 35 N., Rockport, Texas through the 30-day public comment period.
